Observation 2: The Suffering of Christ in the Discharge of His Mediation

1. The sufferings of Christ by virtue of the teaching of Scripture must precede his glory and triumph.

2. The sufferings of Christ are such that our minds being limited in their capacities and made averse by their prejudices, are more glorious than can be rightly conceived.

3. The sufferings of Christ must be viewed from a variety of vantage points in order for us to advance in our view of them.

4. The sufferings of Christ and the seeing of his glory in them, generate different reactions in the thoughts and apprehensions of different categories of men.
